Products and Services

Comcast Digital Cable with ON DEMAND

Comcast Digital Cable offers customers more than 250 channels, including dozens of premium movie channels and music channels. It includes an interactive, on-screen program guide and remote control that lets viewers quickly and easily choose programs and movies by category or channel as well as parental control features to help parents manage the programs that their children can watch.

With On Demand, Comcast's video-on-demand service, Comcast Digital Cable customers can select from more than 3,500 programs using their existing Digital Cable box and watch them at any time. Customers can rewind, fast forward and pause programs, and can store most selections for up to 24 hours from the time of ordering.

High-Definition Television (HDTV)

Comcast's High-Definition Television service offers HDTV programming from local and national broadcast networks, national cable networks and regional sports networks.

Digital Video Recorder (DVR)

Digital Video Recorder service from Comcast lets customers digitally record, store, and enjoy their favorite programs. DVR service also allows users to pause and rewind "live" television.

The Company also has a majority ownership in Comcast-Spectacor, whose major holdings include the Philadelphia Flyers NHL hockey team, the Philadelphia 76ers NBA basketball team and two large multipurpose arenas in Philadelphia.

Comcast was founded in 1963, growing from a single cable television operation serving 1,200 customers in Tupelo, Mississippi, to the industry leader with a presence in 22 of the top 25 U.S. metropolitan areas. The Company currently has over 74,000 employees serving more than 21.4 million cable subscribers, 7.7 million high-speed Internet customers, and 1.2 million cable telephone subscribers.
